Councillor Vacancies – May 2019

The Parish Council has two vacancies for Councillors in Crich Ward.

In order to apply you must fulfil the following criteria:

- Be registered as a local government elector for the parish – give electoral number;
or
- Have occupied as owner or tenant, within the preceding 12 months, land or premises in the parish – give address;
or
- Had their principal or only place or work, during the last 12 months, within the parish – give address;
or
- Have, during the preceding 12 months, resided in the parish or within 4.8 kilometres of it – give address.
- Be 18 years of age or over – give date of birth.
- Not be disqualified for holding office as a member of a local authority – see extracts from the Local Government Act 1972.
- Submit details of any political party membership.
- Be willing to sign-up to the Members' Code of Conduct by signing the electoral compact
- Be willing to complete the Declarations of Interests, to be publicised by Amber Valley Borough Council

To be considered for the role please:

- Submit your CV
- Provide a brief overview of why you should be considered for one of the vacancies
- Outline what you could bring to the role of Parish Councillor

After submission of your application, you will be invited to address the Parish Council, to explain your reasons for wanting to be a Parish Councillor.

The Parish Council will ask questions of each candidate.

You will be notified of the Council's decision as soon as possible.
