**9: Recreation Ground Boundary in the vicinity of Taylor's Yard**

Report from Trustee Group Chair 2020/21 C Collison:

A planning application relating to 3 Taylor's Yard proposed a re-alignment of the Recreation Ground boundary wall. The Parish Council submitted to AVBC an objection to the scheme and in particular opposed any re-alignment of the boundary. In a letter to the applicant the Parish Council stated the Trustee Group has no authority to agree any variation of the boundary. A revised planning application has subsequently been submitted to AVBC. Whilst the Parish Council has objected to the revised scheme this did not include reference to the boundary which in the revised planning application now appears to conform to the existing boundary.

**10: Development of Crich Recreation Ground**

Requests with permission granted have been carried out; planting of an oak tree, planting of the remaining Woodland Trust trees, replacement of Cherry trees.

c) **Enhancement of Crich Recreation Ground**

At the last Trustee meeting of 20<sup>th</sup> July 2020:

“It was agreed that it would be prudent to allow the current plan to be completed and for the plantings undertaken to settle-in during the next 12 months. During this time Trustee Group Members agreed to undertake individual research to look into examples of ‘Friends of’ type groups, to build understanding and seek out Best Practice, which could then be shared via e-mail. Vice Chair offered to look at pulling together a first draft of a possible framework for a ‘Vision’ outlining the overall way forward for the future of the Recreation Ground and what role it should serve in the community.”

The continuance of the Coronavirus pandemic had meant this had not been possible.
