### **F096/22 GRANTS AND DONATIONS**

Annual Community Groups Grant Scheme

The application forms were issued on 31st August 2022, a notice put on the Parish Council website, and the notice board. The closing date is 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022, however, this was then extended to 18<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

The following amount in grants was recommended.

Crich Luncheon Club	£300
Derbyshire Toy Library	£300
Crich Crafters	£180
Muddlealong	£200
Fritchley Community Association	£300

Glebe Field Centre	£700
Crich Parish Well Dressing	£216
Total	£2596

Of the £404 remaining, it was suggested this could be distributed later in the year, or carried forward to next year if not needed.

Offering the grants twice a year instead of once was discussed.

**Resolved:** To continue offering the grants once a year. This will make allocation of grant payments fair for all. We can assess the needs of each group and allocate according to the individual need. We only have a limited amount of money to allocate in grant payments. If we were to keep some money back for later in the year we may have to reduce the amount requested by each group during the first part of the year.
